<b>(FECAL)</b>		<b>DUE IF CANINE PATIENT IS NOT ON FULL YEAR HWP</b>	
<b>CBC</b>		this is a complete blood count. It checks red blood cell, white blood cell, and platelet counts.	
<b>Canine Wellness Profile</b>		this is a mini chemistry panel that checks basic kidney and liver function with a CBC (pre-op screen with a CBC)	
<b>Total Body Function Profile</b>		includes a full chemistry panel, CBC, and thyroid level	
<b>Senior Wellness #1 Profile</b>		includes a full chemistry, CBC, thyroid level, and complete urinalysis	
<b>Heartworm Test</b>		a heartworm test is a blood test that checks for an ADULT heartworm antigen in the blood (if italicized then is included in recommended profile)	
<b>Thyroid test</b>		T4 - the total thyroid level in the blood / Hypothyroidism is a common problem in canines	
<b>Urinalysis</b>		checks for abnormalities in the urine that might indicate infection, kidney disease or bladder stones.	
<b>Dentistry</b>		Proper dental care is a very important part of your dogs overall health. The veterinarians at CPH recommend regular cleanings and oral examinations under anesthesia. All dogs should have their first dental prophylaxis by the age of 3.
