FECAL		some intestinal parasites can be transmitted to humans (especially children). It is important to check for these parasites or regularly		
CBC		this is a complete blood count. It checks red blood cell, white blood cell, and platelet counts.		
Feline Wellness Profile		this is a mini chemistry panel that checks basic kidney and liver function with a CBC (pre-op screen with a CBC)		
Total Body Function Profile		includes a full chemistry panel, CBC, and thyroid level		
Senior Wellness #1 Profile		includes a full chemistry, CBC, thyroid level, and complete urinalysis		
Blood Pressure		Hypertension is common in older cats. It occurs often in combination with renal disease and heart disease.		
Thyroid test		T4 is the total thyroid level in the blood. Older cats are prone to having an elevated thyroid level, caused by a benign tumor of the thyroid gland.		
Urinalysis		Checks for abnormalities in the urine that might indicate infection, kidney disease or bladder stones.		
Dentistry		Proper dental care is a very important part of your dog's overall health. The veterinarians at CPH recommend regular cleanings and oral examinations under anesthesia. All dogs should have their first dental prophylaxis by the age of 3.
